Below you will find information about the tiered pricing of DBT skills groups offered at our practice. We will not ask you to provide proof of your income or wealth when choosing your fee. If there is a fee that is affordable for you that you do not see listed below, please reach out to group facilitators to discuss.

When deciding what fee you will pay, we ask that you consider both your income and access to wealth. Income is the amount of money you make. Wealth is passed down intergenerationally and usually takes the form of inheritances, land ownership, and/or earning power. As a team committed to principles of anti-oppressive clinical practice, we encourage clients who experience systemic oppression that has historically barred access to wealth to apply for subsidized fee spots.
